

Where goods are valued at less than \$2,500.00 Canadian, the formal Certificate of Origin is not required. Instead, the exporter or producer may provide a statement in the form outlines below.

If the goods are already included on a Blanket Certificate of Origin, the statement is not required.

The "Low Value" statement may be handwritten, stamped, or typed on the actual invoice for which preferential NAFTA rates are being claimed.
